

Thanks for contacting us and expressing your interest to attempt the assessments online. This document is aimed at parents who have sent an enquiry and wish to do an assessment. You would not have received a seat offer or have not joined the tuition.

Online Assessment:

- To assess the suitability of new pupils who wish to join the tuition.
- Pupils are usually assessed for English and Maths only. Trial papers are also provided to familiarise children with the online screens.
- The major intake is in Sep for which the assessments happen in the summer months i.e. June/July. The level of our assessments is usually similar to
 - Bond Age 8-9 Assessment papers for Year 4 entry (i.e. our assessment to be done by Year 3 child before August and start classes in Sep)
 - Bond Age 9-10 Assessment papers for Year 5 entry (i.e. our assessment to be done by Year 4 child before August and start classes in Sep)
- From time to time, very few spaces come up during the year. The assessments are taken during the whole tuition year and are classified as 'in-year admissions'. The level of assessment is usually similar to
 - Bond Age 9-10 Assessment papers for Year 4 class (i.e. our assessments to be done by Year 4 child) for in-year admissions
 - Bond Age 10-11 Assessment papers for Year 5 class (i.e. our assessments to be done by Year 5 child) for in-year admissions
- Students aiming to join the Saturday Year 5 super-selective classes may also be needed to do a writing test.
- The assessments would help parents give an idea about our expected level
- Assessments are chargeable only if a seat is offered i.e. if your child is not offered a seat, we will not charge you.
- There are plans to give support to students even if you are declined admissions now so that your child gets in sync and can join at a later date

As you may know, there are significant efforts that go into designing these assessments and making sure that these are 'fit for purpose. Therefore, the details are **confidential**, and the contents are **copyrighted**. It means you can't copy/paste, take photos or print screens etc.

- The online assessment is 'single attempt' only. A trial paper may also be included so that your child gets familiar with the online screen and timer etc. You may provide the basic equipments to your child such as a pencil, rubber, notebook and a water bottle.
- The attempt is counted when you click the **Start** button. If you click the Start button and close the browser (or hit Back button), the test would terminate.
- Parents should login, choose the test and click the Start button. Students should then attempt the test '**independently**' without any assistance from the parents. Students are not expected to click the Start button.
- If there is an IT/Hardware/404 or any other error that happens during the test, we cannot conduct another assessment and you may not be considered for an admission.
- Every effort would be made to provide more assessments, but the service may be withdrawn due to any unforeseen circumstances.

- We have tried our best to eliminate any human errors, but very few questions may have typos.
- The assessments open for over a period of 1-2 weeks so that parents can choose the appropriate time to do the assessment. Each assessment is usually about 30-45 mins long.
- Parents will **not** get the results immediately after completing the assessment.
- The results are reviewed after the deadline for completion has elapsed and majority of enquiry students have taken the assessments.
- The results are assessed in conjunction with other parameters such as siblings, catchment students etc. Some parents may be contacted at this stage to validate the expectations.
- Where the child is deemed as **qualified**, parents are notified on phone/email and a formal seat offer is issued if they choose to join.
- If your child is deemed as not-qualified, we will not charge you. At the same time, due to admin constraints, we may not contact you to notify the results or provide you with any scores/explanation that why your child was not offered a space.
- Our account can only hold a finite number of test takers. If you are planning not join
 our tuition, you must not use the online assessments. We would also disable the
 users who are not using the online actively. Kindly note that you may not be notified
 before being disabled or removed from the online platform.

 - Unique user id
 - Password

- 2. Parents to log in on the classroom link and complete the consent form 'Consent form for Enquiry parents' with a 100% score. Note that you have to tick all boxes in the last question.
- 3. You may wish to notify us (via text) upon completing the consent form. Within 1-3 business days, your view is switched (manually) to display the assessments.
- 4. Your child can do the trial test. It would help him/her to get familiar with the online screens.
- 5. When he/she is comfortable (and not tired), your child can do the asssessment for English and Maths.
